I am writing to express my concern of G.M. crops being released in Victoria. We have come a long way in the development of cropping, through the hard work of farmers collecting and keeping seeds and the research of the Department of Primary Industries. There are a lot of species you can grow in your area that weren't possible in the past, and crops that produce less stubble and more production are just an example.

I wouldn't like to see this work put in jeopardy. If there are benefits of G.M. crops then the public must be informed of trial data comparing G.M. crops to non G.M. Put it back in the laboratory till all major concerns are addressed conclusively eg health and safety, or any actual benefits.
