SECTION C ORDER FOR TRANSACTION TAGS

Transaction tags are a voluntary tag which are used to identify the last owner, and typically the last property of residence, of cattle consigned to saleyards and knackeries. Cattle identified with an NLIS Breeder or Post-Breeder Tag **no longer have to be identified with a transaction tag** provided the consignment is accompanied by a correctly completed current **National Vendor Declaration (Cattle)**. Dead bobby calves that are to be dispatched to a knackery must be identified with either a transaction tag or an electronic NLIS (Cattle) ear tag.

Transaction tags are available in either White or Pink. White transaction tags can be used when selling cattle that have either been treated with Hormonal Growth Promotants (HGPs) or have an unknown HGP status. Pink HGP FREE cattle transaction tags can only be used to identify cattle that you manage and know have never in their lifetime been treated with HGPs. Purchased cattle must have been accompanied by a National Vendor Declaration (NVD), endorsed stock agent invoice or equivalent document stating that the cattle are HGP Free. An NVD declaring that the cattle are HGP FREE must accompany consignments identified with pink HGP FREE tags.
