## **Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Control of Use) Act 1992**

### **NOTICE OF DECISION TO RECOMMEND THE MAKING OF AN ORDER TO PROHIBIT SPECIFIED AGRICULTURAL SPRAYING IN AGRICULTURAL CHEMICAL CONTROL AREAS**

I, Patrick McNamara, Minister for Agriculture and Resources, give notice under section 38(5) of the **Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Control of Use) Act 1992** that I have decided to recommend to the Governor in Council the making of an Order to prohibit specified agricultural spraying in agricultural chemical control areas for the purpose of protecting susceptible plants and stock, public health and the environment.

A notice of proposal to make the Order was published in accordance with section 38(2) of the Act in the Government Gazette on 16 May 1996 and in newspapers circulating generally in the areas to be affected by the Order.

As required by section 38(3) of the Act, the notice of proposal specified the general purpose of the proposed Order, stated where a copy of the proposed Order could be purchased and inspected, and stated that public comment was invited.

Public comments on the proposed Order were received and have been considered in accordance with section 38(5) of the Act.

I have decided to recommend that the proposed Order with some modifications should be made.
