Changes since the Last Edition

In 2008, Fisheries Victoria reviewed recreational fishing regulations as part of the broader process of renewing the *Fisheries Regulations 1998*, which expire every 10 years.

More than 800 submissions were received to proposed changes to catch limits and equipment restrictions.
